

Terms and Conditions of Participation, Safety and Site Regulations, and Liability Provisions

Geocaching Event "LOST IN MV – 4 EVER"

Organizer

The organizer of the geocaching event "LOST IN MV – 4 EVER" is the **Association of Friends and Supporters of the Technical Museum Flugplatz Pütnitz (Verein der Freunde und Förderer des Technischen Museums Flugplatz Pütnitz e.V.)**, in cooperation with **Abenteuer Frischluft e.V.**

Individual program activities may be conducted by independent third parties. Such activities shall be governed exclusively by the respective participation terms and liability provisions of those third parties.

1. Participation

By entering the event premises, and no later than upon completion of the registration process, each participant acknowledges these Terms and Conditions of Participation as legally binding.

Participation is voluntary.

Each participant undertakes not to endanger the safety of other participants and to support the orderly conduct of the event.

Parents or other supervising persons shall bear sole responsibility for the minors entrusted to their care throughout the entire duration of the event.

2. Admission

Access to the event premises is permitted only with a valid event ticket and after successful registration.

The admission wristband must be worn visibly and undamaged on the wrist throughout the participant's stay.

Upon request by the organizer or its authorized representatives, the wristband must be presented at any time.

Any loss of or damage to the admission wristband must be reported to the organizer immediately.

Tampered with or transferred admission wristbands shall become invalid.

3. House Rules and Right to Issue Instructions

Throughout the entire event, the organizer, its volunteers, stewards, security personnel, and other authorized representatives shall exercise domiciliary rights ("Hausrecht") over the event premises.

Participants must comply immediately with all instructions issued by these persons.

The organizer may exclude participants from the event without refund of the ticket price and require them to leave the premises, in particular if they:

- violate these Terms and Conditions of Participation;
- fail to comply with instructions;
- endanger or significantly disturb other persons;
- cause damage to property;
- commit criminal offences or administrative offences;
- seriously disrupt the orderly conduct of the event.

Any further civil or criminal claims shall remain unaffected.

4. Stay on the Event Premises

The event ticket entitles the holder solely to remain on the event premises during the booked participation period.

Upon expiration of the participation period, or following an order to leave the premises, participants must leave the event site immediately.

Any unauthorized stay shall constitute a breach of these Terms and Conditions of Participation.

For each culpable unauthorized stay, the participant shall pay a contractual penalty in the amount of **EUR 100.00**.

The contractual penalty shall be credited against any further claims for damages.

The organizer expressly reserves the right to file criminal charges for trespassing (Section 123 German Criminal Code (Strafgesetzbuch – StGB)) or for any other legal violations.

5. Safety and Site Regulations

All participants are required to show mutual consideration.

In particular:

- Emergency access routes, fire brigade access routes, and supply routes must be kept clear at all times.
- Restricted areas must not be entered.

- Traffic signs, information signs, and barriers must be observed.
- Parking spaces may not be reserved or blocked without authorization.
- Motor vehicles may only be operated by persons holding a valid driving licence.
- A driving ban for motor vehicles applies between **10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.**, except for arrival and departure as well as expressly authorized vehicle movements.
- Open fires, campfires, and barbecue areas may only be used within the designated area and must never be left unattended. If a fire ban is imposed by the competent authorities, all open fires are prohibited.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash throughout the entire event premises.
- The designated quiet hours of the respective camping areas must be observed.
- Every participant shall conduct themselves in such a manner that persons, animals, facilities, and property are neither endangered nor damaged.

Any identifiable hazards or damage must be reported to the organizer immediately.

6. Personal Responsibility

"**LOST IN MV – 4 EVER**" is a volunteer-organized outdoor event.

Every participant acknowledges that camping, geocaching, vehicle demonstrations, workshops, and staying on the grounds of a former airfield naturally involve certain risks.

Each participant independently decides in which program activities to participate.

Participation is at the participant's own risk.

7. Liability

The organizer, its members of the Executive Board, association members, volunteers, and other authorized representatives shall be liable exclusively in accordance with the applicable statutory provisions.

Liability shall exist only in cases of intentional misconduct or gross negligence.

The organizer shall be liable for damages arising from injury to life, body, or health only where such damages result from a culpable breach of duty by the organizer or by a person whose conduct is legally attributable to the organizer.

In the event of a slightly negligent breach of essential contractual obligations, liability shall be limited to the foreseeable damage typical for this type of contract.

In all other respects, liability is excluded to the extent permitted by law.

In particular, the organizer shall not be liable for:

- typical risks associated with an outdoor or camping event;
- weather-related influences;
- uneven ground or the natural condition of the terrain;
- negligence on the part of participants;
- failure to comply with safety instructions;
- damage caused by other participants;
- loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings;
- damage to vehicles, tents, caravans, or motorhomes;
- changes to or cancellation of individual program activities.

Where liability is excluded or limited, such exclusion or limitation shall also apply in favor of all association members, volunteers, vicarious agents, and other persons engaged by the organizer.

8. Liability of Participants

Each participant shall be liable, in accordance with the applicable statutory provisions, for all damage caused by them.

The participant shall indemnify and hold harmless the organizer against any third-party claims arising from the participant's culpable breach of these Terms and Conditions of Participation or of applicable statutory provisions.

9. Duty of Supervision

The organizer does not assume any duty of supervision for children or adolescents.

Such responsibility shall remain exclusively with the respective parents, legal guardians, or designated supervising persons.

10. Photographs and Video Recordings

Photographs and video recordings will be taken during the event.

The organizer may use such recordings for documentation, reporting, and promotional purposes, provided that no overriding legitimate interests of the persons concerned prevent such use.

11. Force Majeure

The organizer shall be entitled to cancel, terminate, or modify the event, in whole or in part, due to force majeure, official orders, or for safety reasons.

To the extent permitted by law, participants shall not be entitled to any claims for damages against the organizer arising from such cancellation, termination, or modification.

12. Final Provisions

Should any provision of these Terms and Conditions of Participation be or become invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected.

The laws of the Federal Republic of Germany shall apply.

Safety and Site Regulations

Geocaching Event "LOST IN MV – 4 EVER"

These Safety and Site Regulations are intended to protect all participants, visitors, volunteers, and the event premises.

By entering the event premises, every participant undertakes to comply with the following regulations.

1. General Rules of Conduct

- Instructions issued by the organizer, its volunteers, stewards, security personnel, and other authorized representatives must be complied with immediately at all times.
- Throughout the entire event, the organizer shall exercise domiciliary rights ("Hausrecht") over the event premises.
- Every participant shall behave with consideration towards others and shall neither endanger, obstruct, nor harass other persons.
- Any identifiable hazards, damage, or safety deficiencies must be reported to the organizer immediately.
- All signs, barriers, and traffic regulations must be observed.

2. Admission and Stay

- Access to the event premises is permitted only with a valid event ticket and proper registration.
- The admission wristband must be worn visibly and undamaged on the wrist throughout the participant's stay and must be presented upon request.
- Any loss of or damage to the admission wristband must be reported to the organizer immediately.
- The admission wristband is personal and non-transferable.
- Entering restricted areas or remaining outside the designated event areas is prohibited.
- Upon expiration of the booked participation period, participants must leave the event premises immediately.

3. Vehicle Traffic

- A walking pace speed limit applies throughout the entire event premises.
- Motor vehicles may only be operated by persons holding a valid driving licence.
- Operating vehicles under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
- Designated one-way systems and traffic routing must be observed.
- Escort and support vehicles may enter the event premises solely for arrival and departure unless expressly authorized by the organizer.
- A driving ban for motor vehicles applies daily from **10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.**
- Vehicles must be parked in such a manner that emergency routes, fire brigade access routes, supply routes, and neighboring pitches remain unobstructed at all times.

4. Safety Zones

- Entering the airfield, vehicle demonstration tracks, technical operating areas, or any cordoned-off areas is prohibited.
- During vehicle demonstrations and other program activities, all prescribed safety distances must be observed.
- Emergency access routes, fire brigade access routes, and supply routes must neither be driven on nor obstructed.

5. Fire Safety

- The use of fireworks or pyrotechnic devices is prohibited throughout the entire event premises.
- Open fires, campfires, and barbecue areas may only be used within the designated area and must never be left unattended.

- If a fire ban has been imposed by the competent authorities or the applicable forest fire warning level prohibits open fires, all open fires are forbidden.
- All fire safety instructions issued by the organizer must be complied with without exception.

6. Cleanliness, Quiet Hours and Environmental Protection

- Every participant is responsible for helping to keep the event premises clean and orderly.
- Waste must be disposed of exclusively in the designated waste containers.
- Sanitary facilities must be used with care and kept clean.
- Avoidable noise, particularly between **1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.**, must be avoided.
- The designated quiet hours of the respective camping areas must be observed.

7. Animals

- Dogs must be kept on a leash throughout the participant's stay.
- Dog owners must immediately remove and properly dispose of any waste left by their animals.
- The owner shall bear sole responsibility and liability for any animals brought onto the event premises.

8. Vendors and Commercial Activities

- Sales stands, promotional activities, commercial operations, and vendor services are permitted only with the prior approval of the organizer.
- Any commercial use of the event premises without prior authorization is prohibited.

9. Visitors

Participants who bring visitors onto the event premises are responsible for ensuring that those visitors comply with these Safety and Site Regulations and leave the event premises no later than upon expiration of their authorized period of stay.

10. Violations

Violations of these Safety and Site Regulations may, in particular, result in one or more of the following measures:

- a warning;
- immediate exclusion from individual program activities;
- removal from the event premises;
- exclusion from the event without refund of the ticket price;
- enforcement of the contractually agreed contractual penalty;
- assertion of civil law claims;
- filing of a criminal complaint where a criminal offence has been committed.

The decision regarding such measures shall be made by the organizer in the exercise of its domiciliary rights ("Hausrecht").

We kindly ask all participants to show mutual consideration and support so that **"LOST IN MV – 4 EVER"** will be a safe, fair, and unforgettable experience for everyone involved.
